Each year the Central Ohio Chapter of SFPE holds a golf outing to raise money for the Ohio State University - Wexner Medical Center Burn Center Development Fund.

The Center for Burn Care at The Ohio State University Medical Center is a multidisciplinary center trained to care for patients with all types of burns. The unit sees hundreds of patients every year, including fire fighters who are injured in the line of duty.

With the help of doctors, nurses, social workers, pharmacist, dieticians, physical/occupational therapists and chaplains; the team works to return every patient to their original lifestyle.

This annual golf outing raises money for the Ohio State Wexner Medical Center Burn Development Fund. There are many ways this fund provides support and assistance to patients and families whose lives have been affected by the ravages of fire:

- Assist with funding to operate burn survivor support sessions and events.
- Provides burn compression garments for patients who could otherwise not afford them - Burn injured patients can suffer tremendous physical and psycho-social disability from scars, with a significant economic impact. Burn compression garments are one of the treatment options to try to lessen the impact of scars.
- Garments, wigs, food, clothing, housing for burn patients and families.
- Support of our SOAR (Survivors Offering Assistance in Recovery) Program. The SOAR program is a national program offered through the Phoenix Society, a burn survivor support network. SOAR provides

one on one peer support for burn survivors and loved ones. We have trained 5 new peer supporters and 1 new SOAR coordinator in 2016- 2017, money raised at the golf outing helped provide the training. The Phoenix Society offers a World Burn Congress annually. This is a program for burn survivors, their families, medical providers and first responders attend and meet and support each other in a welcoming and supportive environment. There are classes offered on self-care, healing and emotional support throughout the weekend. Burn Funds have been used to send staff members to World Burn to be trained.

- Provides support to educate EMS and other providers on how to care for burn patients.
- Collaborate with OSU Department of Student Affairs and the Columbus Division of Fire to educate the OSU students both on and off campus.
- Participate in research to improve outcomes of burn patients and minimize the devastating effects of burns.

Enhancing staff performance and patient rehabilitation through the use of speaker programs and specialized burn care conferences and educational opportunities.
